Professor Carmen Vives Cases is professor of Preventive Medicine and Public Health at the University of Alicante (since 2018). Doctor and graduate in Sociology (2004 and 1998 respectively). Vice Dean of Research, Postgraduate Studies and Internationalisation of the Faculty of Health Sciences at the University of Alicante (2016-2020). Head of the Equality Unit of University of Alicante (from 2021- ongoing). Professor Carmen Vives Cases was awarded Honorary Doctor at Umeå University in 2019.

Her research activity focuses mostly on the study of gendered violence from the perspective of public health, consolidated with her leadership in different national and European projects and nearly two hundred publications.
